CARES is easier than ever!

- Declare your major in Child Development or Early Childhood Education at your community college through the Office of Admissions.
- Meet with the CARES college counselor at MPC or Hartnell to create or update your Education Plan.
- Apply for a \$500 incentive if you reside in Monterey County and you complete six qualifying college units with a grade of C or better, between January 1-2011 and June 20, 2012. Incentives will be distributed on a first-come, first-serve basis.
